Technology (TapHere) have signed an agreement which provides a contract vehicle for **Video Extraction & Encoding Services** that is available to state agencies in the Commonwealth of Virginia, public higher education institutions, local governments, school boards, agencies serving local governments and non-profit, educational institutions involved with the **Virtual Library of Virginia (VIVA)**. Under the terms of this **Commonwealth of Virginia Contract**, eligible agencies can utilize TapHere to **extract** analog or digital multimedia content from many original formats such as VHS/MPEG/DVD/DV and **convert/encode** to multimedia streaming formats suitable for presentation on the web or a closed network/intranet.
